EDUCATIONAL NOTICE

Admission into P.G. Courses in the 4 Medical Colleges of Assam, Session, 2018.

It is for general information that the candidates whose names appeared in the State of Assam merit list of NEET-PG-2018 conducted by National Board of Examination and who has served in the remote & difficult areas as mentioned below are hereby directed to apply in plain paper to the undersigned for awarding additional marks as per following rules of Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission to PG courses) Rule, 2006 and submit the same in the Drop Box which will be available at the Office of the DME, Assam (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor).

*"In determining the merit in the Entrance Examination for Post Graduate admission, additional mark shall be given at the rate of 3% of marks obtained in the Entrance Examination against completion of each year of service in 'remote & difficult areas' subject to the maximum of 9% of the total marks obtained, provided the candidate produces certificate/ certificates to the effect issued by the DHS/DHS (FW) Assam & Jt. DHS of Assam of the concerned area, in the format as prescribed at Appendix-IV.*

*Provided that total marks obtained after inclusion of additional marks shall not exceed the total marks of the Entrance Examination.*

*Provided, however that the period of service in remote and difficult area shall be counted with effect from 01-01-2010 onwards only and service offered prior to this date shall not be counted for awarding this additional marks.*

*Provided also that Doctors serving in rural area in establishment other than establishment of the Govt. of Assam or Society/Agency created for implementation of National Programmes of disease control or N.H.M. shall not be eligible to be awarded additional marks as mentioned above."*

REMOTE & DIFFICULT AREAS IN ASSAM (As per the amendment notification in the Assam Gazette dated the 13<sup>th</sup> January/ 2010.

"Remote and Difficult Area" means an area which is situated in the two hill Districts of Assam i.e. North Cachar, Hills and Karbi Anglong District as well as remote areas namely, Dhemaji District, Sadia Sub-division, Majuli Sub-division, Dhakuakhana Sub-division and South Salmara sub-division other than the head quarters of the said Districts/Sub-division". However all concerned candidates are requested to go through the original gazette notification thoroughly.
