EDUCATIONAL NOTICE

Admission into the 1st year B.D.S. course in the Government Dental Colleges of Assam for the session 2019.

The candidates who appeared in the 2nd counseling of BDS course held on 27th August, 2019 and selected by the Selection Board in different categories and Government Dental Colleges are hereby allowed for provisional admission into the 1st year B.D.S. courses in the Government Dental Colleges of Assam for the session, 2019 as per the select list to be published in the official website of DME, Assam (www.dmeassam.gov.in) on 30/08/2019 at 5 pm.


The candidates are hereby directed to report for admission to the Principal of the respective Government Dental Colleges along with their all original testimonials, allotment letter issued at the time of counseling, etc. on 2nd & 3rd September, 2019 with the following conditions as stated below:

- 1 Candidates are to deposit the original Admit Cards, Marks Sheets, Pass Certificates of HSLC and HSSLC or Equivalent examination, PRC, certificate of EWS, caste certificate and NCL to the Principal of the respective Government Dental Colleges at the time of admission.
- 2 The admission of the candidates are subject to the satisfactory Medical fitness certificate issued by the Medical Board arranged by the Principals of the concerned Dental Colleges.
- 3 All the candidates shall have to enter into an agreement as per the admission rule of Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges of Assam, (Regulation of Admission into 1st year MBBS/BDS courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2019 in prescribed format which is available in the admission rule stated above, published in this directorate website www.dme.assam.gov.in.

Candidates will have to execute and submit the deed of agreement within 15 days from the date of their admission.

- 4 All admissions are provisional.
- 5 College uniform is compulsory for all the students in all the Colleges. College authorities shall prescribe necessary dress code.
- 6 Admission fees is approximately Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) only
- 7 If any candidate fails to report for admission into the BDS course within the stipulated time, his/her allotted seat shall be forfeited.

The Select list shall be published in the official website of the DME, Assam www.dmeassam.gov.in on 30/08/2019 at 5 pm.
