Mop-up round Counseling for Selection into the Post Graduate Courses in the Medical Colleges of Assam and B.B.C.I., Guwahati for the Session 2020.

It is for general information to all the candidates that the Ministry of Health, Govt. of India has reduced the percentile cut offs for NEET-PG, 2020 by 20 percentile, taking them to 30 percentile (cut-off score-275) for General (UR/EWS) category, 25 percentile (cut-off score-252) for Person with Disabilities (UR) category and 20 percentile (cut-off score-230) for SC/ST/ OBC category.

In pursuance of above, a Mop-up round counseling for admission into the Post Graduate courses in the Medical Colleges of Assam and B.B.C.I., Guwahati for the session 2020 against remaining vacancy will be held on 28th July/2020, 11 AM onwards. In view of the present situation due to COVID-19 pandemic the Mop-up counseling will be held through Online Platform and the link for connecting counseling the will http://360sslive.com/webcast/counselling/. Candidates whose names have appeared in the State of Assam merit list of NEET-P.G.-2020 conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi and who are qualified in the said merit list as per the above mentioned conditions as well as who have fulfilled all the eligibility criteria for admission into P.G. courses as per Assam State P.G. Admission rules are hereby requested to appear for the Mop-up round counseling as per schedule mentioned above. Candidates who have already been admitted as per 1st and 2nd round counseling may also appear the Mop-up round counseling for change of Course and College against available vacant seats as per merit position.

The counseling will be held in the following order, subject to availability of categorywise vacancies:-

- 1. State Health Services Quota
- OBC/MOBC
- 3. SC
- 4. ST(P)
- 5. ST(H)
- 6. Unreserved category

The reserved category seats shall be filled up first and any seats remaining vacant thereof shall be opened for Unreserved category. Further, all remaining candidates should stay in the counseling till the end of process of counseling so that any seat that become vacant on the same day may be filled up according to merit position.

In this Mop-up round, counseling for EWS seats will not be held as the matter is subjudice, vide Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Guwahati Case No. WP(C)/2853/2020. It may be mentioned here that selection to the Post Graduate EWS quota seats, result of which was kept withheld as per Order of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Guwahati in relation to Case No. WP(C)/2853/2020, dated 15/07/2020 is subject to the outcome of the case.

IMPORTANT:

- A) Selected candidates will have to take admission in their allotted Colleges/Institute on or before 4 PM, 30th July, 2020, failing which his/her candidature will be forfeited.
- B) Candidates shall have to deposit all original documents as specified in Assam Medical College (Regulation of Admission to Post Graduate Courses) Rules, 2006 (Amendment up to 2012) at the time of admission. Fresh candidates without the original documents as specified will not be allowed to get admitted in their allotted seats and the seats allotted to them will be treated as vacant.
- C) Latest vacancy status will be published on 27th July, 2020 in our official website www.dme.assam.gov.in.
- D) The admission fee for the session 2020 has been waived by the Govt. of Assam due to prevailing COVID-19 situation. However, other ancillary fees like Hostel Fees, Counseling Fee etc. will have to be paid to the respective Colleges/Institute at the time of reporting.
