NOTIFICATION

The 30th September, 2022

No. HLB.170/2007/Vol-II/425.- The Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules, further to amend the Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges of Assam, (Regulations of Admission into 1st year MBBS/BDS Courses) Rules, 2017 hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, in the following manner, namely:-

Short title and commencement

- (1) These rules may be called the Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges of Assam, (Regulations of Admission into 1st year MBBS/BDS Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2022.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette and shall be applicable from the academic session 2022 to regulate the admission of students into the MBBS/BDS courses in the Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges of Assam, respectively.

Substitution of Schedule III

2. In the principal Rules, for the existing Schedule-III, the following shall be substituted, namely:-
