

MINUTES OF THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 04/06/2020 IN THE O/O THE DME ASSAM FOR EVALUATION OF THE TECHNICAL BIDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE EOI FLOATED (NO.DME/28/AIIMS/2020/4456 DTD 20/03/2020) FOR RENTED PREMISES TO SET UP THE TEMPORARY ESTABLISHMENT OF AIIMS, GUWAHATI

Evaluation of bids:

It was found that only one bidder has participated in the bidding process:

M/s. Kalita Mercantile Pvt.Ltd.

The bidder is the same lone firm which had also participated in the 1st – time EOI. The Committee after scrutiny of the technical bid document of the bidder noted the following:

1. All requisite documents as per EOI has been submitted
2. Marks obtained by the bidder: Since there exists only one bid, it was not felt necessary to follow the marking system for screening of bids.
3. The bidder appears to be fulfilling the requirements of the EOI, including those in the Corrigendum issued, and accordingly the technical bid of the bidder is found to be qualified.

Conclusion:

The Technical bid of the only bidder, M/s. Kalita Mercantile Pvt.Ltd. is found to be qualified. As required by the EOI, site visit has been done by technical teams from the Directorate of Medical Education, Assam and also by a team of AIIMS Bhubaneswar (Mentor institute of AIIMS Guwahati) and the premises offered by the bidder has been found to be suitable for the intended purpose for which the EOI has been floated.

The EOI has been floated for the 2nd time, allowing adequate publicity in each time through the print media and official website of the DME Assam, and also allowing sufficient time for submission of bids. However, only one party has shown interest in the EOI. It appears that further floating of the EOI will not result in any larger participation of bidders, and accordingly, the Committee suggests that the process of this EOI may be taken forward, and as required by the EOI terms, the technically qualified bidder may be invited to submit its Financial Bid.

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
